## Section I. Instructions to Bidders

<b>A. General</b>	
<b>1. Scope of Bid</b>	<p>1.1 The Purchaser <b>indicated in the BDS</b> issues this Bidding Document for the supply, delivery of Goods and Related Services incidental thereto as specified in Section V, Schedule of Requirements.</p> <p>1.2 Throughout this Bidding Document :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) the term “in writing” means communicated in written form with proof of receipt;</li> <li>(b) if the context so requires, singular means plural and vice versa; and</li> <li>(c) “day” means calendar day.</li> </ul>
<b>2. Source of Funds</b>	<p>2.1 NEA, in accordance with its annual program and budget, intends to apply a portion of the allocated budget to eligible payments under the contract(s) <b>indicated in the BDS</b> for which this Bidding Document is issued.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>The NEA has applied for or received financing (hereinafter called “funds”) from the Development Partner (hereinafter called “the DP”) <b>indicated in the BDS</b> toward the cost of the project <b>named in the BDS</b>. The NEA intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the contract(s) for which this Bidding Document is issued.</p> <p>2.2 DP Funded: Payment by the DP will be made only at the request of the NEA and upon approval by the DP in accordance with the terms and conditions of the financing agreement between the NEA and the DP (hereinafter called the “Loan Agreement”), and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of that Loan Agreement. No party other than the NEA shall derive any rights from the Loan Agreement or have any claim to the funds.</p>
<b>3. Fraud and Corruption</b>	<p>3.1 Anticorruption related laws require that GoN’s officials (including beneficiaries of funds), as well as bidders, suppliers, and contractors and their sub-contractors under GoN/DP-financed contracts, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, this bidding document;</p> <p>(a) defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) “corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another party;</li> <li>(ii) “fraudulent practice” means any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;</li> <li>(iii) “coercive practice” means impairing or harming, or</li> </ul>

	<p>threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of a party;</p> <p>(iv) “collusive practice” means an arrangement between two or more parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing improperly the actions of another party.</p> <p>(v) “obstructive practice” means:</p> <p>(aa) deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering or concealing of evidence material to the investigation or making false statements to investigators in order to materially impede a NEA/DP investigation into allegations of a corrupt, fraudulent, coercive or collusive practice; and/or threatening, harassing or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation; or</p> <p>(bb) acts intended to materially impede the exercise of the NEA/DP’s inspection and audit rights provided for under sub-clause 3.5 below.</p> <p>(b) will reject bid(s) if it determines that the bidder has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices in competing for the contract in question;</p> <p>(b) will sanction a firm or individual, including declaring ineligible, for a stated period of time, to be awarded a GoN/DP-financed contract if it at any time determines that the firm has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices in competing for, or in executing, a GoN/DP-financed contract.</p> <p>3.2 The Bidder shall not carry out or cause to carry out the following acts with an intention to influence the implementation of the procurement process or the procurement agreement :</p> <p>(a) give or propose improper inducement directly or indirectly,</p> <p>(b) distortion or misrepresentation of facts,</p> <p>(c) engaging in corrupt or fraudulent practice or involving in such act,</p> <p>(d) interference in participation of other competing bidders,</p> <p>(e) coercion or threatening directly or indirectly to cause harm to the person or the property of any person to be involved in the procurement proceedings,</p> <p>(f) collusive practice among bidders before or after submission of bids for distribution of works among bidders or fixing artificial/uncompetitive bid price with an intention to deprive the Employer the benefit of open competitive bid price,</p> <p>(g) contacting the Employer with an intention to influence the Employer with regards to the bids or interference of any kind in examination and evaluation of the bids during the period from the time of opening of the bids until the notification of award of contract.</p> <p>3.3 Without prejudice to any other rights of the Purchaser under the</p>
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	<p>related laws, GoN may <b>blacklist</b> a Bidder for its conduct for a period of one (1) to three (3) years on the following grounds and seriousness of the act committed by the bidder:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) if convicted by a court of law in a criminal offence which disqualifies the Bidder from participating in the contract,</li> <li>(b) If it is proved that the bidder has committed an act contrary to ITB 3.2.</li> </ul> <p>3.4 A bidder declared blacklisted and ineligible by the GoN, Public procurement Monitoring Office (PPMO), and/or the DP in case of DP funded project, shall be ineligible to bid for a contract during the period of time determined by the GoN, PPMO and/or the DP.</p> <p>3.5 The Supplier shall permit the GoN/DP to inspect the Supplier's accounts and records relating to the performance of the Supplier and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the GoN/DP, if so required by the GoN/DP.</p> <p>3.6 DP Funded: In pursuance of the fraud and corruption policy, the DP.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) will reject a proposal if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices in competing for the contract in question;</li> <li>(b) will cancel the portion of the loan/ credit/ grant allocated to a contract if it determines at any time that representative(s) of the GoN or of a beneficiary of the fund engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices during the procurement or the execution of that contract, without the GoN having taken timely and appropriate action satisfactory to the DP to address such practices when they occur.</li> </ul>
<p><b>4. Eligible Bidders</b></p>	<p>4.1 This Invitation for Bids is open to eligible Bidders/Suppliers indicated <b>in the BDS</b>.</p> <p>4.2 A Bidder may be a natural person, private entity, government-owned entity (subject to ITB 4.4) or any combination of them with a formal intent to enter into an agreement or under an existing agreement in the form of a Joint Venture (JV). In the case of a JV:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) all parties to the JV shall be jointly and severally liable; and</li> <li>(b) a JV shall nominate a representative who shall have the authority to conduct all businesses for and on behalf of any and all the parties of the JV during the bidding process and, in the event the JV is awarded the Contract, during contract execution.</li> </ul> <p>4.3 A Bidder shall not have a conflict of interest. All Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A Bidder may be considered to be in a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process if, including but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) have controlling shareholders in common;</li> <li>(b) receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from any of them;</li> <li>(c) have the same legal representative for purposes of this Bid;</li> <li>(d) have a relationship with each other, directly or through</li> </ul>

	<p>common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the Bid of another Bidder, or influence the decisions of the Purchaser regarding this bidding process;</p> <p>(e) a Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all Bids in which it is involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the same subcontractor, not otherwise participating as a Bidder, in more than one bid; or</p> <p>a Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the goods and services that are the subject of the bid.</p> <p>4.4 A Bidder that is under a declaration of ineligibility by the GoN/DP in accordance with ITB 3.4, at the date of the deadline for bid submission or thereafter, shall be disqualified.</p> <p>4.5 A GoN-owned enterprise may also participate in the bid if it is legally and financially autonomous, it operates under commercial law, and it is not dependent agency of the Purchaser.</p> <p>4.6 Bidders shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility satisfactory to the Purchaser, as the Purchaser shall reasonably request.</p> <p>4.7 Firms shall be excluded in any of the cases, if</p> <p>(a) by an act of compliance with a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations prohibits any import of goods or Contracting of works or services from that country or any payments to persons or entities in that country.</p> <p>(b) DP Funded: as a matter of law or official regulation, GoN prohibits commercial relations with that country, provided that the DP is satisfied that such exclusion does not preclude effective competition for the supply of goods or related services required;</p> <p>(c) DP Funded: a firm has been determined to be ineligible by the DP in relation to their guidelines or appropriate provisions on preventing and combating fraud and corruption in projects financed by them.</p>
	<p>4.8 A bidder and all parties constituting the Bidder shall have the nationality of an eligible country as defined by the concerned DP for DP funded projects.</p> <p>4.9 The domestic Bidder who has obtained Permanent Account Number (PAN) and Value Added Tax (VAT) registration certificate(s) and Tax clearance certificate or proof of submission of tax return from the Inland Revenue Office shall only be eligible. The foreign bidder submitting the documents <b>indicated in the BDS</b> at the time of bid submission and a declaration to submit the document(s) <b>indicated in the BDS</b> at the time of contract agreement shall only be eligible</p>
<p><b>5. Eligible Goods and Related</b></p>	<p>5.1 All goods and related services to be supplied under the contract are eligible, unless their origin is from a country <b>specified in the BDS</b>.</p> <p>5.2 For purposes of this clause, "origin" means the place where the</p>

<b>Services</b>	goods are mined, grown, or produced, or the place from which the related services are supplied  5.3 The origin of goods and services is distinct from the nationality of the Bidder.
<b>6. Site Visit</b>	6.1 For goods contracts requiring installation/ commissioning/ networking or similar services at site, the Bidder, at the Bidder's own responsibility and risk, is encouraged to visit and examine the Site and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the supply of goods and related services.  6.2 The Bidder should ensure that the Purchaser is informed of the visit in adequate time to allow it to make appropriate arrangements.  6.3 The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the Bidder's own expense.

Contract Forms</p> <p>7.2 The Purchaser will reject any Bid submission if the Bidding Document was not purchased directly from the Purchaser, or through its assigned office <b>as stated in the BDS</b>.</p> <p>7.3 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the Bidding Document as well as in Amendments, if any. Failure to furnish all information or documentation required by the Bidding Document may result in the rejection of the Bid.</p> <p>7.4 The Invitation for Bids issued by the Purchaser is not part of the Bidding Document</p>
<b>8. Clarification of Bidding Document/Pre-</b>	8.1 A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the Bidding Document shall contact the Purchaser in writing at the Purchaser's address <b>indicated in the BDS</b> . The Purchaser will respond in writing to any request for clarification, provided that

<b>bid meeting</b>	<p>such request is received within the time limit <b>specified in the BDS</b> prior to the deadline for submission of Bids. The Purchaser shall forward copies of its response to all Bidders who have acquired the Bidding Document directly from it, including a description of the inquiry but without identifying its source. Should the Purchaser deem it necessary to amend the Bidding Document as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under <b>ITB 9 and 24.2</b>.</p> <p>8.2 The purchaser may organize a pre-bid meeting of Bidders at least ten (10) days before the deadline for submission of Bids at the place, date and time as <b>specified in the BDS</b> to provide information relating to Bidding Documents, Technical specifications and the like matters. Should the purchaser deem it necessary to amend the Bidding Document as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under <b>ITB 9 and ITB 24.2</b>.</p>
<b>9. Amendment of Bidding Document</b>	<p>9.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of the Bids, the Purchaser may amend the Bidding Document by issuing addenda.</p> <p>9.2 Any addendum issued shall be part of the Bidding Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the Bidding Document directly from the Purchaser.</p> <p>9.3 To give prospective Bidders reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their Bids, the Purchaser may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of the Bids, pursuant to <b>ITB 24.2</b>.</p>

### C. Preparation of Bids

<b>10. Cost of Bidding</b>	<p>10.1 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid, and the Purchaser shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.</p>
<b>11. Language of Bid</b>	<p>11.1 The Bid, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Purchaser, shall be written in the language <b>specified in the BDS</b>. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Bid may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the language <b>specified in the BDS</b>, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, such translation shall govern.</p>
<b>12. Documents Comprising the Bid</b>	<p>12.1 The Bid shall comprise the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Bid Submission Sheet and the applicable Price Schedules, in accordance with <b>ITB Clauses 13, 15, and 16</b>;</li> <li>(b) Bid Security in accordance with <b>ITB 21</b>;</li> <li>(c) alternative bids, if permissible, in accordance with <b>ITB 14</b>;</li> <li>(d) written confirmation authorizing the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder, in accordance with <b>ITB 22</b>;</li> <li>(e) documentary evidence in accordance with <b>ITB 17</b> establishing the Bidder's eligibility to bid;</li> <li>(f) documentary evidence in accordance with <b>ITB Clauses 18 and 31</b>, that the Goods and Related Services conform to</li> </ul>

This form must be completed without any alterations to its format, and no substitutes shall be accepted. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested.</p> <p>13.2 The Bidder shall submit the Price Schedules for Goods and Related Services, according to their origin as appropriate, using the forms furnished in Section IV, Bidding Forms</p>
<b>14. Alternative Bids</b>	<p>14.1 Unless otherwise <b>indicated in the BDS</b>, alternative bids shall not be considered.</p>
<b>15. Documents Establishing the Eligibility of the Bidder</b>	<p>17.1 To establish their eligibility in accordance with ITB 4, Bidders shall:</p> <p>(a) complete the eligibility declarations in the Bid Submission Sheet, included in Section IV, Bidding Forms; and</p> <p>(b) if the Bidder is an existing or intended JV in accordance with ITB 4.2, submit a copy of the JV Agreement, or a letter of intent to enter into such an Agreement. Documents Establishing the Conformity of the Goods and Related Services to the Bidding Document</b>	<p>18.1 To establish the conformity of the Goods and Related Services to the Bidding Document, the Bidder shall furnish as part of its Bid the documentary evidence that the Goods and Related Services conform to the requirements specified in Section V, Supply Requirements.</p> <p>18.2 The documentary evidence may be in the form of literature, drawings or data, and shall consist of a detailed item-by-item description of the essential technical and performance characteristics of the Goods and Related Services, demonstrating substantial responsiveness of the Goods and Related Services to those requirements, and if applicable, a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of Section V, Schedule of Requirements.</p> <p>18.3 Standards for workmanship, process, material, and equipment, as well as references to brand names or catalogue numbers specified by the Purchaser in the Section V, Schedule of Requirements, are intended to be descriptive only and not restrictive. The Bidder may offer other standards of quality, brand names, and/or catalogue numbers, provided that it demonstrates, to the Purchaser's satisfaction, that the substitutions ensure substantial equivalence or are superior to those specified in Section V, Schedule of Requirements.</p>
<b>19. <b>36. Post-qualification of the Bidder</b>	36.1 The Purchaser shall determine to its satisfaction whether the Bidder that is selected as having submitted the lowest evaluated and substantially responsive Bid is qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily. 36.2 The determination shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to ITB 19. 36.3 An affirmative determination shall be a prerequisite for award of the Contract to the Bidder. Purchaser's Right to Vary Quantities at Time of Award</b>	39.1 At the time the Contract is awarded, the Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of Goods and Related Services originally specified in Section V, Schedule of Requirements, provided this does not exceed the percentages <b>indicated in the BDS</b> , and without any change in the unit prices or other terms and conditions of the Bid and the Bidding Document. 39.2 If the bidder whose bids is accepted fails to sign the contract, the Public Procurement Monitoring Office shall blacklist the bidder on recommendation of the Public Entity.
<b>40. Notification of Intention to Award</b>	40.1 The Purchaser shall notify the concerned Bidder whose bid has been selected in accordance with ITB 38.1 within seven days of the selection of the bid, in writing that the Purchaser has intention to accept his/her bid and shall Inform via the Letter of Intention included in the Contract Forms and the information of name, address and amount of selected bidder shall be given to
